Exam Conditions: (please note these are taken directly from the senior exam conditions – they are noted so that juniors become accustomed to sitting tests / exams under ‘exam’ conditions)
-You are required to remain in class for the entirety of your exams. You are welcome to bring a book to read if you think you may finish early - (Juniors - you may study for another exam at these times).
-School uniform is to be worn for the exams (Full **formal** uniform is **not** required).
-Students may bring water into the exams – **NO FOOD**.
-**Over the period of an exam, normal exam protocols will be enforced. Talking or communicating could result in removal from the exam. NO cell phones or Watches (of any kind) are to be brought into the exam rooms.**

*****Reminder to all junior students - The Senior students start their formal NCEA exams on Wed 7 November. These will run mainly in the Auditorium, Chapel, and V Block. Please be aware and play well away from these areas over the time of senior exams. On occasion there will be senior exams in other venues – we will notify when this is to occur and the same consideration will need to be given at those times. Thank you.**
