

Senior 'Internal Evidence Exams' 2019 (Years 11, 12, 13) **Tuesday 15th October to Friday 18th October 2019**

General:

-All senior students will be on exam leave over the period of the IE exams. The library is available as a study area for those students attending school during the exams.

Exam Conditions:

- All exams are three hours unless notified otherwise by staff. Students may not leave the exam in the first 45 minutes or the last 15 minutes.
- Morning exams run from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Afternoon exams run from 1:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.
- School uniform is to be worn for the exams (Full **formal** uniform is **not** required).
- Students may bring water (only) into the exams – NO FOOD.
- Over the period of an exam, normal exam protocols will be strictly enforced (as they will be at the end of year). Talking or communicating will likely result in removal from the exam, and may impact upon entry to end of year exams.
- No mobile phones, Watches (of any kind) or electronic devices are to be brought into the exam rooms.
- **Students arriving more than 30 minutes after the exam has started will not be able to sit the exam or enter the exam room**

Clashes

Absences

In the event of a student missing an assessment due to valid reasons (medical, family emergency etc), they should contact **Ms Hullena (Director of Curriculum)** as soon as they can to make alternate arrangements for the exam to be completed. A Medical Certificate will be required to cover absence from any examination.

Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Commerce Exams

Students will be brought into the exam room 15 minutes early to allow for the resetting of Graphics calculators. Calculators must be of a model approved by NZQA or your teacher.

***It is essential students understand the importance of these exams. The results from these exams provide the evidence of students achievement in relation to NZQA externally assessed standards should illness or exceptional circumstances prevent your son from attending his end-of-year exams in November. For Years 11 and 12 they may also contribute to entry to subjects for the following year (if a student is border-line for entry).**
